Type	Long greenhouse english type.
Plant Characteristics	BACCARA is extremely vigorous and has large dark green leaves which support the high yield potential. The root system is extremely well developed and supports the plant and abundant fruit. BACCARA may require additional (10 - 15% more) K, Ca and B than standard mixes to help the plant maintain these bumper yields. Due to production under low temperatures and light levels, it is important to allow the plant to develop its full potential by pruning more fruits from the main stem (between the first eight leaves) in order to maintain good levels of light and ventilation to the fruit on the laterals, some laterals need to be pruned. Allow the main stem to grow until 30 - 40cm's over the wire and the top of the plant. Grow only two laterals and top them when they are 50cm long.
Fruit Characteristics	The fruit of BACCARA are dark green and moderately ribbed. Fruit length can be regulated by allowing an extra lateral to develop, i.e. by setting more fruit. Fruit length is +/- 32 - 35 cm in winter and +/- 35 - 40 cm in summer.
Diseases Resistance	High Resistance to Ccu (<i>Cladosporium cucumerinum</i>) and Cca (<i>Corynespora cassicola</i>). Intermediate Resistance to PM (Powdery Mildew).
Adaptation	Heated winter greenhouses, but used widely throughout the year in South Africa.
Yield Potential	BACCARA is capable of producing very high yields during the winter.
Plant Spacing	18,000 to 22,000 plants per ha.
Features and Benefits	The large leaves of BACCARA combined with its well developed root structure support the high yield potential. High quality large to extra large fruit, depending on the season.
