Type	A hybrid Piel de Sapo melon with long shelf life.
Maturity	Main season 85 - 95 days.
Plant Characteristics	A very vigorous plant with a healthy leaf cover that protects the fruit against sunburn. Easy fruit set under cool conditions.
Fruit Characteristics	Harvest indicators include a change in rind colour from dark green to a mid-green mottled appearance, the development of netting on the skin, and a change in the groundspot colour from light green to bright yellow. Large to extra-large sized fruit with weight of 2.8 – 4.2kg. The fruit shape is long oval to oval. The fruit have firm, white flesh, with very good flavour and high brix, with very long shelf life and medium seed cavity.
Disease Resistance	High Resistance: Fusarium wilt (Fom: 0,1). Intermediate Resistance: Powdery Mildew (Px:1,2,5/ Gc), MNSV.
Climate	Optimum germination temperature: 25°C to 28°C, night temperature not lower than 18°C. Optimum growth temperatures at night are 18 - 20°C, and day 24 - 30°C, and for ripening 15 - 25°C.
Plant Spacing	4,000 to 8,000 plants per ha
Adaptation	KANELA is recommended for early and late, to winter season production.
Yield Potential	Very high yield potential.
Features and Benefits	KANELA produces very high yield of large to extra-large fruit with a dark green, netted appearance and excellent post-harvest shelf life. The fruit have firm, light green-white flesh, with excellent flavour and high brix, and is suitable for fresh-cut and the fresh market.
