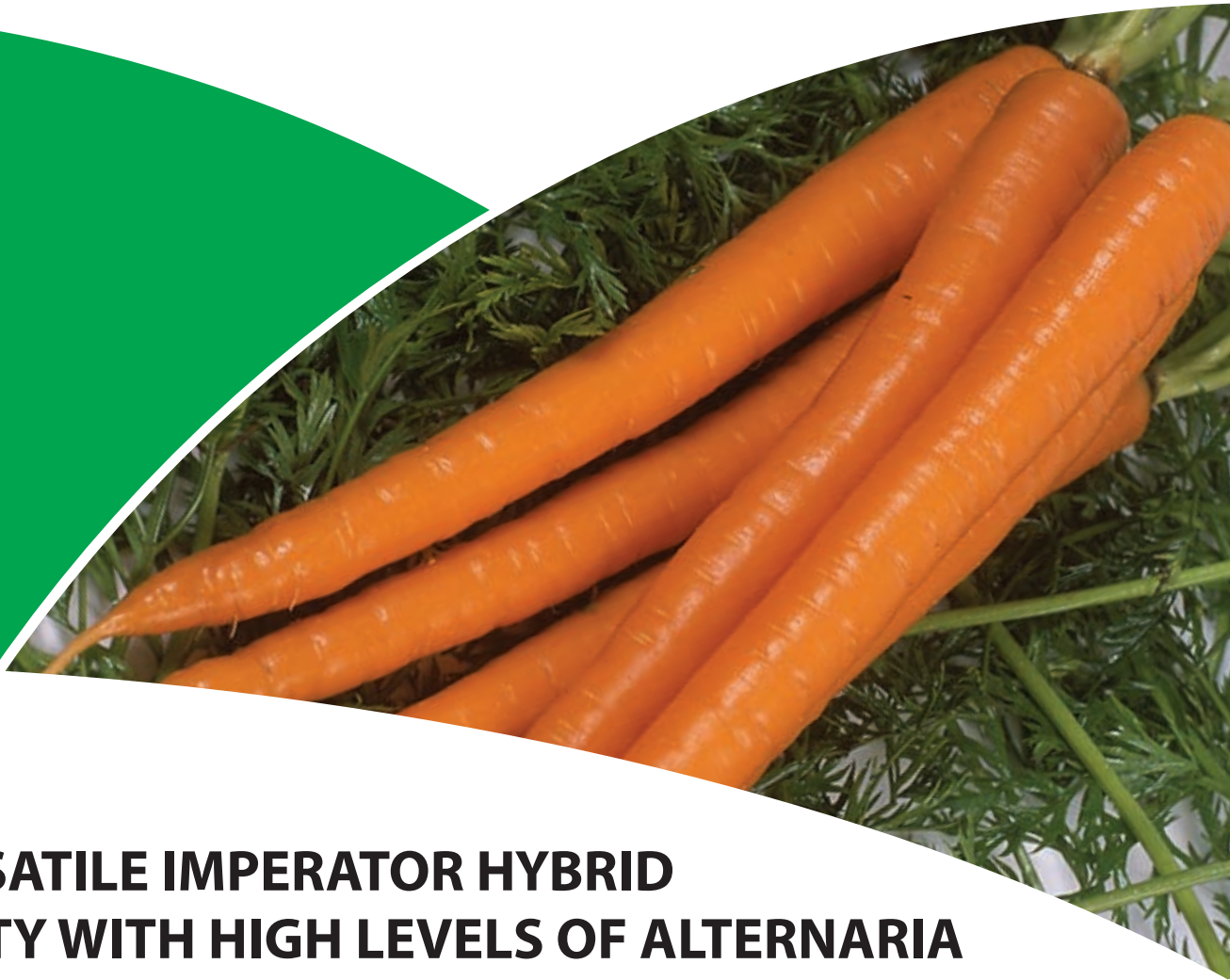

Leaf Characteristics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leaf Colour: Light green • Leaf Length: Medium length, large • Habit: Moderately Upright • Attachment: Strong (can be lifted mechanically) 																										
Root Characteristics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Root Length: 23 – 25 cms • Root Shape: Slight taper with semi-blunt tip • Root Colour: Deep orange, very small core • Texture: Smooth • Maturity determined by shoulder diameter (usually 2cm) 																										
Bolting	Good bolting tolerance																										
In-situ Storability	Good storability as this type of carrot grows indefinitely																										
Disease Resistance	High Resistance: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alternaria (Ad) • Cercospora (Cc) 																										
Growing Guidelines	<p>Sowing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure good seedbed preparation prior to sowing. Sowing densities between 3 and 3.5 million seeds per hectare are recommended. <p>Fertilization:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emperor carrots have a naturally lighter green foliage compared to Nantes carrots. Do not try to remedy with additional Nitrogen fertiliser 																										
Features and Benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High foliar disease resistance – reduces the dependence on chemical control of foliar diseases and therefore lowers production costs. • Good taste - well suited for the baby whole production due to its excellent culinary qualities and good taste.
