CONICAL SWEET PEPPER

Type	A hybrid conical sweet pepper range turning from dark green to intense yellow, red or orange – depending on the variety planted. Suitable for open field production and cultivation under protection.																																				
Maturity	Approximately 75 - 80 days to first pick in summer plantings. The period to first pick can vary considerably depending on the season.																																				
Plant Characteristics	TRENINO has a compact plant habit with good leaf cover preventing sun damage to the many small fruits. The hybrid could be grown untrellised, or trellised to two wires to ensure optimal yields and fruit quality. Plant population should be between 2.5 - 3 plants/m ²																																				
Fruit Characteristics	THE TRENINO RANGE has an average fruit mass of between 20 - 40 grams. Fruit shape is small conical (snacking size) shape. Quality of the brightly colored fruits are very good, with a very smooth and glossy skin. TRENINO (all 3 varieties) has the ability to set fruit under hot conditions. The fruits of this range is of excellent taste, all of these varieties' brix-values ranges from 9 – 10.																																				
Yield Potential	TRENINO has the potential to produce high yields - 3.5 - 5 kg/m ² .
